

## **Good News! Tweedsmuir Church is Re-opening for In-Person worship.**

Session has supported the recommendation of Tweedsmuir's Covid -19 response committee, and will open, at 25% capacity for in-person worship, on Sunday, July 11th. Services will continue to be available virtually. All Covid-19 protocols, as mandated by the Province and our local Health Unit will continue to be observed. Please note the following:

- Please screen yourself at home for Covid-19 symptoms before attending church. Do not attend if feeling unwell.
- Upon entering the NORTH DOOR, please put on your mask (over nose and mouth), sanitize your hands. The volunteer at the door will take your name in case future contact tracing is required.
- Please keep the required physical distance of 2 metres between you and parishioners who are not in your family, and sit in the pews that are not roped off
- You may exit via north and south door
- Remember that through the Marilyn Taylor Memorial Taxi Fund, you may arrange for a free taxi service to and from Tweedsmuir. Please call 519-941-8000, and when booking the cab, let them know to charge account 474. When you arrive at the church, obtain a receipt from the driver and put receipt in the collection plate

We are so thankful to our Heavenly Father for keeping us safe and healthy during this pandemic, and for enabling health officials to guide us through these challenging times. As of the date of this writing, 77% of the folks living in this health unit district have received their first vaccination and 33.3% their second. Case counts, as well as hospitalizations due to Covid have plummeted and again as of this writing, only 2 patients are in intensive care in local hospitals. Immunizations and strictly following protocols works.
